Here are some helpful tips when photographing:

THINK BEFORE YOU CLICK: Think about what you are looking at and why you are interested. The camera won't decide for you—it's just a tool!

USE NATURAL LIGHT: Photographers are always out taking pictures before the sun comes up, and long after it goes down to get the perfect light for their pictures.

FULL FRAME: Arrange your picture by thinking about the objects that surround the subject of your photograph. Fill the whole frame with interesting elements.

CHANGE YOUR PERSPECTIVE: Be creative by getting down on your stomach or carefully climb a tree to see things from a new angle. Photographs are a great way to show friends and family how you see the world.

KEEP SHOOTING: Don't spend too much time looking at the pictures on your digital camera, it uses up the batteries quickly!
