- Assist with summer camp programming
- Work with Educators during General Admission hours to teach basic, intermediate and advanced art and technology skills to youth and families
- Prepare, maintain and troubleshoot equipment and supplies in the exhibit/production areas; identify and report status of exhibits and supplies
- Responsible for opening and closing the museum floor and reporting on all issues related to running the museum.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Strong interest in art, education, STEAM education, museum studies, or media studies desired
- Experience working with children
- Good computer skills, ability or interest to learn and teach new software
- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Fluency in Spanish, Mandarin, Cantonese, or Tagolog a plus
- Experience working with families and community groups a plus
