



Museum Policies

The Children's Creativity Museum is a community-based nonprofit organization, welcoming visitors of all ages, backgrounds, and communities. Safety is one of our most important concerns.

- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times, including in restrooms and public areas. Parents, guardians, caretakers, and other authorized adults accompanying young children are responsible for the behavior and supervision of their children while at the museum. The Children's Creativity Museum is not responsible for any consequences resulting from unsupervised children.
- To ensure that our community can imagine, create, and share in a safe environment, adults 18+ who visit the Children's Creativity Museum must be accompanied by a child. Adults without children who wish to schedule a tour of the museum are encouraged to email info@creativity.org. Tours are subject to availability and must be confirmed in advance.
- Food and drink are not allowed inside the museum. Please enjoy snacks and beverages outside in Yerba Buena Gardens.
- Admission to the museum grants the Children's Creativity Museum and its designees full authorization and permission to create, reproduce, distribute, display, copyright, publish, or otherwise use any images or recording, by or through any media for art, advertising, or organizational development or promotion purposes. Admission waives any right to inspect or approve the final form and finished products for which these images and recordings are used.
- No pets are allowed inside the museum.
- We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone to preserve the health and safety of our visitors and staff.
